On July 27, 2007 Governor Corzine signed into law the New Jersey Stem Cell Research Bond Act. Based on this Act, New Jersey voters will be asked in the Nov. 6th General Election whether to authorize the spending of \$450 million over 10 years on grants to fund stem cell research. To help voters decide on this ballot issue, the October 23rd Forum will provide participants with factual information on stem cell science and legislation and an opportunity to raise questions. 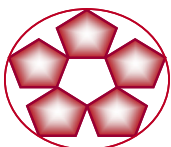
